## **JNA 2020 PRESIDENTS REPORT**

In an unprecedented year like no other, we saw the world grind to a halt.

The first few months of 2020 saw a very different start to the season than we were used to.

Normally Clubs and their members would've been on court training, learning new skills, meeting new teammates and coaches and having played their first game of the season.

Instead, we were self-isolating, self-distancing and struggling with the very real possibility of no sport during 2020.

Together JNA, our governing bodies and Clubs collaborated, implementing new protocols and safety requirements necessary to see the start of a season. Together we worked as one to ensure members were back on court sooner rather than later. There were many late night and weekend meetings, new policies created and protocols formulated to ensure we were able to offer a Winter season to members.

We were very fortunate to begin our season late June, allowing a 13 game Winter season. I'm very proud of the way JNA handled all COVID-19 challenges and grateful for the support and willingness to cooperate received from Clubs and wider members during this very challenging time.

Regardless of the challenges that COVID-19 set upon us, there remained much success on and off the court for JNA during 2020. As we entered our 23rd year, with support from clubs and members, families and the committee our Association continued to grow with new club members, development programs, initiatives and policies. 2020 proved another solid and successful year for JNA.

This year I had the privilege of attending the courts each game day. I watched athletes play with enthusiasm, displays of fine sportsmanship, volunteer heroes, – all of whom build upon our standing within the community and strengthen our Association.

Through the joint efforts of committee members and clubs we continue to develop and modify our policies and protocols to successfully manage JNA and ensure all members benefit from the resources and programs which comprise the fabric of netball within our Association.

This year JNA had 13 clubs and independent teams, 1184 athletes and 118 teams registered for Winter season. Following through the development pathway we saw another very successful year for our JETS program. We had 4 teams participate in the Metro League, 10 teams participate at the Fuel to Go and Play Association Championships, culminating in our 17B team winning the grand final for their division.

Due to restrictions surrounding spectators for games, this year we introduced live streaming for some of our games, presentations as well as the Fuel to Go and Play Association Championships long weekend. In addition, we posted photos from the courts each game day. Both initiatives have been widely welcomed by members and one we wish to continue next year.

JNA continue to build our umpire base and were fortunate to have 72 squad umpires for Monday night games who were committed to officiating games, championship carnivals and JETS training sessions. Following the Winter season, we welcomed 23 new umpires into our Green Shirt program which was facilitated throughout the Spring season of netball.

JNA achieved Good Sports level 3 accreditation this year; one that promotes JNA within the wider community as a preferred Association to join and be part of. In addition, we were proud to have a JNA case study published by 'Play By the Rules', sharing our successes with other sporting associations and clubs throughout Australia. Play by the Rules is a unique collaboration between Sport Integrity Australia, Sport Australia, Australian Human Rights Commission, all state and territory departments of sport and recreation, all state and territory anti-discrimination and human rights agencies, the Office of the Children's Guardian (NSW) and the Anti-Discrimination Board of NSW.

JNA continue to encourage and embrace inclusiveness by providing Clubs a choice of gender-neutral uniform options for members. This has proved popular and further develops our aim to be an Association known for diversity and inclusiveness.

To build upon this and promote inclusiveness within the wider community, we now announce an Indigenous 'Welcome to Country' prior to all games, committee meetings and club meetings at our Association.

To encourage our Clubs and members to remain connected during the challenging COVID-19 times, JNA introduced a new Volunteer Acknowledgement Initiative and Sportsmanship Acknowledgement. The purpose was to encourage involvement, connect members, recognise and promote association volunteers. Each game day, myself and the JNA Vice President attended the courts to meet, greet and thank volunteers. Volunteers included coaches, assistant coaches, team managers, umpires, scorers, timers, first aiders, parents assisting and club officials. All volunteers selected were presented a certificate and complimentary voucher for a hot drink from the local Coffee van. The initiative was promoted on our social media pages, through Association Clubs and our local sponsor. At the completion of our Winter competition, we'd officially acknowledged approximately 75 volunteers.

This year I'm proud to have presented a JNA Life Member award to Jennie Wood, for her service to JNA over the past 10 years.

To the outgoing executive committee of 2020, the Association owes much of its success this year to your dedication and tireless work.

You have all volunteered precious time, energy and worked toward continuing to build and promote our great Association.

The year started well, as our Metro League teams prepared for the 2020 season. All 4 Head Coaches had gained Intermediate Level Accreditation, the training had gone well, and we began the competition with high expectations. Unfortunately, with only 2 weeks of the regular season remaining, and with both the U14 and U16 teams fighting for Finals places, the season was cut short with the outbreak of coronavirus, and the competition was abandoned. I would like to commend all of the Athletes and Coaches involved with our Metro League teams. It is the highest level of competition available to our Association, and to play or coach at this level is a real honor. All involved should be congratulated.

When Netball finally returned it was in a very different format, with sign in sheets, sanitizer and social distancing the new norm. Thankfully this did not affect the Athletes spirit as we embarked on the road to the Fuel to Go and Play Association Championships. This year the program introduced a Strength and Conditioning Program with Mandy Hopper, and Coach Mentoring provided by Julie How.

As always there were highs and lows at the Association Championship, but overall, the 11 teams we sent, including a Masters team for the first time, performed above expectation. I would like to highlight the achievements of the U14B's who reached their Grand Final, and the U17B's who won the Grand Final of their division, with a display of real courage, to come from behind and win an outstanding final.

With rearranged schedules this year it meant that less than 2 weeks after the Association Championships we were running trials for JETS 2021. The trials went well and I am confident that the squads we are assembling will step up again next year. Congratulations to all who made the squads, it is not easy to do, and you should be proud of your achievements. No one makes a JETS squad without hard work and determination.

October saw Jan Rowe return, as Future JETS Coordinator, to deliver Phase 1 of her outstanding development program to our U10 rising stars. Thank you to all of the Coaching Staff, and Senior JETS Athletes who give up their time to make this initiative possible, and good luck to all Athletes who are selected for Phase 2 in 2021.

The final Development initiative of the year saw the arrival of superstar shooter Sarah East. Sarah brings a wealth of experience and knowledge to the JETS program, and the 7 week clinic she ran for the U12 and U13 JETS shooters was an outstanding success.

I would like to thank all of the coaches, managers, committee members, and parents for all that you do to make everything possible.

Away from the playing side of the game I would like to thank Sharon Knott for taking on the role of JSO (JETS Support Officer) as we look at ways to support our athletes in all facets of their lives.

A final thank you to Rod and Michelle O'Donnell, and Viv and Kaylene in the office. Without their hard work behind the scenes, none of what we do would be possible.

This year's focus was on creating the JETS family culture, upskilling our coaches, and expanding the development program. Let's see what 2021 brings.

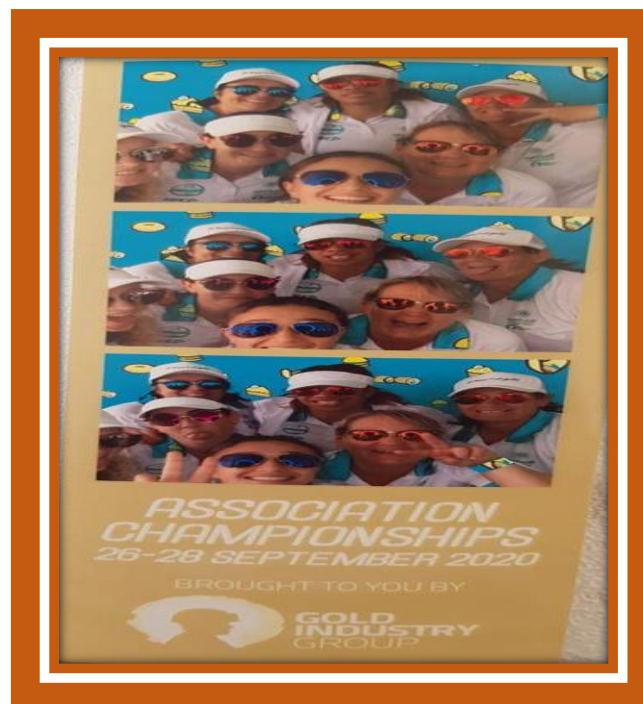
On behalf of the JNA Senior Convenor and myself we would like to thank all umpires that helped to sanitize all of those that came through the main gate we couldn't have done it without you
