## **JNA 2023 PRESIDENTS REPORT**

Welcome to all Members,

2023 has been another successful and positive year for Joondalup Netball Association. We continued to maintain a strong membership base and recognition as an inclusive and progressive Association within the region.

The 2023 season saw the implementation of a new competition format at JNA. The trialled format provided an opportunity for a competition based upon playing a wider range of teams throughout the season, with an increased opportunity for finals placement. The format presented some challenges along the way, and we thank all clubs and members for their understanding and support as we adjusted and worked through issues.

During round 3 we celebrated the official opening of our resurfaced netball courts. We celebrated the day with local politicians, community members, clubs, and members. In addition to our new playing courts, we're thrilled with the commencement of new amenities at the courts. Following a Labour party election commitment, Emily Hamilton provided integral assistance for a new public amenity toilet and changeroom facility being built next to the JNA courts. The new amenities will benefit all Association clubs, members, and spectators.

This year saw continued popularity for our Winter NET and school holiday programs. Round 3 saw JNA commemorate our annual Indigenous round. We were fortunate to welcome back Noongar Yamatji woman Sharon Wood-Kenny who conducted a Welcome to Country and smoking ceremony at the courts. The Indigenous round has become a popular round on our netball calendar and we look forward to its continued success.

Embracing and encouraging community awareness, round 4 saw JNA celebrate our annual 'Pink' round, with all proceeds to the Breast Cancer Network Australia.

During the Spring season our members supported local firefighters, with donations going to the City of Wanneroo Volunteer Bushfire Brigade. We thank our committed clubs and members for consistently supporting JNA community initiatives.

2023 was another successful year for the JNA Green Shirts Umpiring program. JNA had 6 clubs participate in the program during 2023. Under the professional guidance of our Umpire Development Officer, Grant Hicks, our new umpires were mentored, skilled and educated regarding the finer points of umpiring. We thank all of our Green shirt umpires who participated this year and look forward to seeing them on court next season.

## **JNA 2023 UMPIRE DEVELOPMENT OFFICER REPORT**

The year started with the Fuel to Play and Go Association Championships in June. Seven C Badged Umpires managed a total of 70 matches across three days, all performing well and in sometimes atrocious weather conditions.

We commenced the Green Shirt program this Spring with 22 new umpires. Green Shirts were mentored at a ratio of two umpires to one mentor, which is a fantastic ratio. This gave a more positive learning experience for everyone and the results and feedback on their progress was promising.

We had 100% of the Green Shirt umpires complete this course, with six umpires receiving their C Badge accreditation. The other umpires will move forward to work towards their C Badge next Winter.

An Umpire Audit was conducted and was well received by most clubs. The audit revealed that almost everyone Umpiring Full Rules games are qualified and competent.

Having a Team White with 100% of Umpires nationally accredited is something most associations dream of. It also shows that we are dedicated to providing the best training available with continual support.

The audit also identified areas where we could improve the learning of our umpires.

There are gaps in pathways between the modified rules umpires and the full rules umpires.

Next season, and with assistance from the clubs in supplying mentors, we can bridge this gap and assist those who want to learn and improve to attain their national qualifications.

In early 2024 we will be planning information sessions open to Coaches, Umpires and interested parties in the new 2024 Rules of Netball, Game Management and General Rules Discussions to provide insights into what is expected of everyone involved in playing in, and officiating matches.

## **JNA 2023 COMPETITION COORDINATORS REPORT**

### **Winter**

The JNA Board recognised a need to explore alternative competition structures for the 2023 winter season. The season's fixtures were customised to suit the number of teams registering for each grade with the intention of having more teams play each other therefore a variety of skills exposed to a larger number of opponents.

The outcome for the season was mixed with no definitive format suitable for a standardised competition format.

A survey was conducted and answered by 61% of teams who participated in the survey of the winter 2023 season. The following significant results were then presented at the annual Club Conference.

- 1) Unanimous support for a grading meeting prior to the start of season.
- 2) 61% of the relevant teams responded.
- 3) Assessing what we consider to be acceptable goal differences and what is not acceptable.
- 4) The preferred number of times you want to play an opponent is max 3 times with 30% of the responses indicating twice is enough times.
- 5) 79% responded that there was no merit in playing in tiers before playing in divisions
- 6) Only 20% of the responses showed support for a tiered system in 2024
- 7) The written responses to an alternative structure were not attempted by all who responded. The trend was a minimum of 6 teams in a grade in 2024
- 8) Responses indicated a tiered system generated more accuracy to determine divisions.
- 9) 43% of the responses did not consult with players
- 10) The responses indicated any match with a goal difference of 20 or less goals was acceptable.

The presentation has been included in the club conference minutes.

A comparison of the 2022 competition format and the 2023 competition format was conducted based of key survey responses and yielded the following.

11U: The 2022 season format produced a higher percentage of acceptable matches 77% vs 72% in 2023. 12 teams participated.



12U: The 2022 season format produced an equal percentage of acceptable matches 60% vs 60% in 2023. 16 teams participated.

13U: The 2022 season format produced a higher percentage of acceptable matches 65% vs 43% in 2023. 11 teams participated.

15U: The 2022 season format produced a higher percentage of acceptable matches 69% vs 54% in 2023. 17 teams participated.

18U: The 2022 season format produced a lower percentage of acceptable matches 59% vs 75% in 2023. 13 teams participated.

Opens: The 2022 season format produced a lower percentage of acceptable matches 71% vs 77% in 2023. 20 teams participated.

There are several considerations required to create a competition structure. The biggest factors are the number of teams available in a grade, the skill levels of all players in a grade and the number of weeks to assign to ladder competition points such that a three-, or two-week finals series can be applied.

It is recommended that a minimum of 6 teams be placed per grade which will allow for 5 weeks grading, 10 weeks of competition where teams play each other twice before 3 rounds of finals.

Critical to this standardised format is the placing of teams within a grade into division after the 5 weeks of grading.

The NSG grades were not impacted by the experimental competition format and appropriate regrades and adjustments were made to accommodate 7U's in the 8U competition.

## **Spring**

The Spring 2023 season structure was in-line with previous years and teams were allocated to division based on the winter season results. Regrading was applied to the u15 and Open grades to the benefit of the competition.

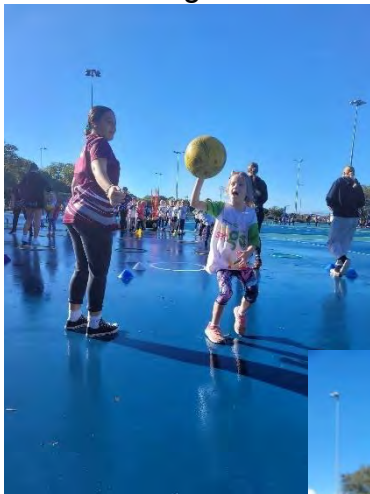

### ACSRA Board Report

December 2023

As we reflect on the past twelve months of a healthier “covid-reduced-year,” we are pleased to have welcomed our active and engaged ACSRA members, volunteers, employees, and sponsors to the Joondalup Sports Club (JSC). We appreciate your support, hard work, and patronage.

The central theme this year has been rising costs and a looming economic recession worldwide, and for all our members; with cost reduction discussions pervading most meetings. Our members’ main issue this year has been – “how do we keep our community kids and adults involved in sport, despite increased member costs?”

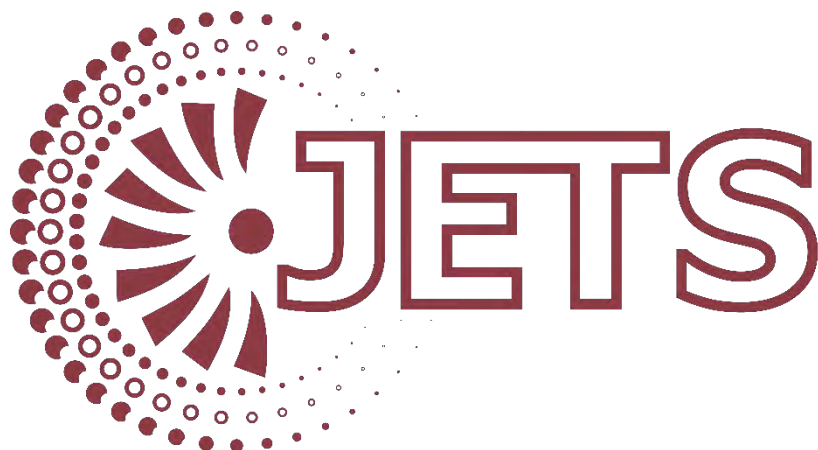
