## JNA 2025 PRESIDENT'S REPORT

2025 concludes the second year of my term as President of JNA. At our 2025 Annual General Meeting (AGM), we welcomed Laura Gallagher (Saints Netball Club) into a General Board Member role and formalised Emma Oliver (Kinross Netball Club) into the Secretary role following her kind offer of appointment in Sept 2024. We were delighted to appoint Alana Penny (Currambine Netball Club) as Vice President of JNA following her successful terms as a General Board Member. We also pleasingly retained Kerry Collings (Independent) in her role as Treasurer, Nicole Hanigan (Butler Netball Club) and Alison Clark (Beaumaris Netball Club) in their roles as General Board Members.

### **Vision, Purpose, Values, and Strategic Focus**

2025 was the second year of our team working towards common goals and our 3-year strategic plan. Our vision is “to be the association of choice in the northern suburbs, harnessing the power of team sport to improve the wellbeing of our netball community”. Our planning meetings each year are aligned to each of the focus areas summarized below and each board member is aligned to one or more areas of this plan. This helps to ensure we maximise progress and achieve our vision and purpose.

### **Game Day, Community Engagement and Fundraising**

In 2025 we continued our work to ensure that the community and our members enjoyed our game day environment. We also utilised our community engagement to fundraise, providing the association additional funds to support our members. The association promoted and / or raised funds for breast cancer (BCNA), Shooting Stars, Ronald McDonald House, Linley Valley Pork and the WA Belt Up campaign.

We worked with Emily Hamilton MLA (Labor party Member for Joondalup) to secure a \$10,000 grant to invest in equipment to improve our game day experience, update our JETS players and umpires uniforms and support umpire wellbeing. Joondalup Netball Association are very grateful for the ongoing support we receive.

### **Development Programs and Inclusion Initiatives**

Our programs this year included NSG (winter and spring, in addition to clinics in Feb and July), No Limits (including a tournament held in June), JETS (squad development, member association championships and Metro), and Future JETS (squad development and carnival). We extend our gratitude to Kerry Joubert, Jan Rowe and Ellie Walters for managing these programs and to the volunteers who supported them in coaching, umpiring, and administration. These valuable programs support our aim to increase participation, be inclusive, and develop our players.

We continue to look for ways to increase indigenous player participation and cultural awareness at Joondalup. Our Indigenous round saw our younger athletes engage with local bracelet making and face painting and we raffled netballs painted with beautiful indigenous designs from Helen Stacey Latham to raise money for Shooting Stars, a program that uses netball as a vehicle for empowering young Aboriginal women living in remote WA.

JNA performed well at the FTG&P associations championships with our 14U A team becoming premiers of their division and our No Limits Comets achieving a brilliant runner up for their division. JNA also put forward teams for the Metro Development competition and our 16U team were 16U Division 2 winners. We are incredibly proud of all players who participated in these competition formats and extend our congratulations to these teams who have achieved special status in 2025.

### **Umpire Wellbeing and Development**

In 2025, we had a reduced size spring competition, owing to 2024 including a sizable proportion of WDNA members requiring to be included in our competition, who have now returned to WDNA. Despite this, we managed to take on 36 green shirts in Spring (the same as 2024). Thanks to Grant Hicks, Alana Penny, our umpire mentors and all our club umpire coordinators for facilitating this. We look forward to seeing these new umpires develop further in 2026. In September, we held a game management workshop. It was hosted by Jerome Gillbard and was well attended by umpires, coaches, team managers and players, with more than 50 attendees. This workshop helped give our umpires the tools they need to manage challenging situations.

### **Club Engagement**

JNA held a Club Conference in October 2025 in order to gain invaluable feedback on the season and to identify focus areas for our association planning day, which was held in November. Focus areas for 2026 included improvements to our competition format and grading process, additional support for umpires and stricter behaviour management for spectators and team officials. At our yearly planning meeting it was agreed that club engagement for 2026 will increase with 3 opportunities per year. The aim of these meetings is to gather feedback on our delivery of our programs and to gain further input into our strategic plan.

### **Financial Performance**

Financially, we had a strong year in 2025, with overall revenues decreasing by only 2% despite an anticipated decrease, due to a much smaller Spring season, with the WDNA members returning to WDNA.

We did increase our fees in 2025, as a result of increased costs from our premises, staffing, equipment and increased fees charged by Netball WA and Netball Australia.

We were delighted to see a substantial increase in our diversity and inclusion programs including No Limits and Future Jets, whose income was high. Our fund raising and grant income increased intentionally to avoid having to pass on the additional costs of running the association to members.

Whilst our financial statements show a loss of \$23k in 2025, we had a delay receiving court reimbursements in comparison to 2024. \$28k of court rebates for winter 2025 were received in February 2026, rather than 2025. If these had been included in 2025 numbers, we would have shown a \$5k profit. JNA remains satisfied with the balance it has achieved, ensuring sustainability of the association and providing good value for the community and our members.

Please refer to our financial statements for more information. These are currently unaudited but will be redistributed if any changes are made post-audit.

### **Membership Growth - Participation**

The association are pleased to report a 7% growth in our winter season participation, which was in line with our yearly (self-set) target for growth. Our Spring season saw a decline compared to 2024 (where we housed WDNA teams in Spring). Our numbers remain 20% higher than 2023 showing continued growth trajectory despite the 2024 anomaly and an underlying 10% growth with WDNA numbers taken out from 2024 to 2025.

Our focus will remain on inclusion and entry programs with targets for No Limits, NSG and Future Jets being stretched in 2026.

### **Acknowledgments**

Our administration and office manager Kaylene Barnett took some well-deserved time away on long service leave. The JNA Board appointed coverage through a mix of fixed term project worker - Laura Robertson and 2 casual office administrators - Surjit Williams and Carolyn Macneall. We would like to thank Laura for her fantastic efforts in bringing our governance documentation in line with changing requirements as well as covering with short notice when absences required it. We would like to thank to Surjit Williams for her coverage of office administration and club queries throughout the winter and spring season in 2025. Surjit offered up some extensive hours coverage when required to ensure programs such as Green Shirts were successful. We would like to welcome and thank Carolyn Macneall who also started to work with us in October 2025 and is currently working with Kaylene to cover the setting up of our new 2026 season and providing invaluable support to the board.

We welcomed new and some familiar faces into our Game Day Convenor pool, including Darlene Dale, Caitlyn Davison, Ronnie Gray, Rima Korau, Kate Hopkins, Carolyn Macneall, Alana Penny, Jesse Te Paki and Lisa Schulz. We would also like to thank board members Alison Clark and Laura Gallagher for investing many hours ensuring that game days run smoothly. Your volunteered time, enthusiasm, kindness and support of incidents was greatly appreciated by our member clubs and The Board.

Our umpires and umpire coordinators play an incredibly important part of keeping us safe and ensuring that our competition is managed within our officiating guidelines. The umpire team remain an ongoing focus for JNA with plans to further strengthen, develop and provide wellbeing support for this team. Thanks to Grant Hicks (Development AUDO) and Alana Penny (Game Day AUDO) for the important role they play in supporting the clubs and umpires at JNA.

We continue to try and diversify our board and subcommittee to ensure new thinking, broad club and game day knowledge and specific skill sets that we need for the future. Please consider getting involved in our wonderful netball community – these roles can be incredibly fulfilling and are greatly appreciated by our members.

JNA would like to thank the subcommittee, office team, game day team, our dedicated umpires, and all club committee members and volunteers for their time, commitment, and ongoing support.

To our clubs, independent teams and their members, thank you for the effort and teamwork that brought together athletes, volunteers, and supporters and made 2025 a successful year at JNA.

### ADO

#### **NET Program 2025**

Our NET Coordinators Dave and Sienna, along with their amazing and enthusiastic coaches held our Winter, holiday clinics and Spring programs throughout 2025.

#### HOLIDAY CLINIC – FEBRUARY

Our preseason holiday clinic saw 21 participants enjoy some great preseason fun! All supported by 5 incredible coaches too. What a great way to start off and get excited for the season ahead!

#### WINTER NET

Our Winter NET program kicked off in May, with plenty of new faces and smiles to take part in our very popular 8-week program. We had 36 participants register to participate in our Winter program, assisted by 13 coaches, across many of our clubs, to ensure we deliver a fun, yet introductory, skill-based program to all our 5 and 6-year-olds.

#### HOLIDAY CLINIC – JULY

These holiday clinics have proven to be very popular with our superstar NetSetGo players! Our session was held indoors over 3 courts to help ensure all our NetSetGo players can still enjoy some netball fun, even when the weather is looking a bit gloomy in the Winter season. 19 super enthusiastic players participated, with 6 coaches helping out.

#### SPRING NET

Our Spring program, which has been running for 7 years now at our association, had 50 participants register for this incredible program, with 8 of our amazing coaches helping out.

#### **Future JETS**

Our Future JETS program kicked off in March 2025 with 43 registering for Phase 1 and 22 selected into Phase 2. We saw our U11 players participating in this program take part in strength and conditioning session by Mandy Hopper, specialist session by former WANL player Sarah East and Advanced Coach Jessamyn Lumb.

Our Future JETS Phase 2 teams took part in their first carnival at West Coast Warriors. We were also fortunate enough to host Belmont Netball Association for a round robin at our JNA courts as part of further development for our Future JETS players.

#### **No Limits**

Our No Limits crew and team had one incredible year! They not only participated in FTGAP, but also took part in several carnivals throughout the year. This ensuring we maintain support for all our players and teams as much as possible. Both of our No Limits teams reached finals at the FTGAP, only narrowly missing out on the top spots!

Ellie and her crew did one amazing job!

## **JETS**

This year, we entered 10 teams at the FTGAP. It was a tough for some of our teams as they faced some tough competition throughout the weekend. But with the introduction of our new JETS uniform, our players wore them with pride and enthusiasm representing our Association. A Development Accreditation course was offered at our association this year. 8 of our association's coaches attended and achieved their Development Accreditation. Well done to all those new Development coaches! We hope to see them involved in many of our development programs in future.

## **JETS Awards**

Our JETS awards were held in June with recognition and awards handed out to some of our most talented players as well as some of players recognised for their good sportsmanship within our program.

## **Metro Development Competition**

4 of our JETS teams participated in the MDC held over the Spring season. This was a particularly tough competition this year, with only 2 divisions per age group and competing against some of the much bigger associations such as PNA, FNA and WDNA.

## JNA 2025 ASSOCIATION UMPIRE DEVELOPMENT OFFICER'S REPORT

### AUDO (PROGRAMS)

The 2025 season commenced with a game management information session for coaches, umpires and interested members. More than fifty attended. The session clarified expectations and reinforced consistency under the updated interpretations.

In preparation for representative duties, new umpire polo shirts were designed and approved ahead of the Fuel to Go and Play Association Championships. The shirts align with the current JETS uniform and incorporate the JNA JETS Indigenous and heritage patterns. A proposal has been submitted to the JNA Board, recommending an association wide adoption for umpires with two or more years' experience on game days, to provide a consistent and professional presentation.

Over the June long weekend, eleven C badged umpires represented JNA at the Fuel to Go and Play Association Championships. Across three days, 111 matches were officiated. In addition to supporting Eaton, Denmark and Kununurra Netball Associations with senior fixtures, JNA umpires also supported the JNA No Limits teams throughout the Championships. This ensured consistent standards across all divisions and reinforced the Association's commitment to inclusive competition.

During the Championships, Sarah Phipps was Talent Identified for the Netball WA Fever In Time Umpire Program, recognising her performance and potential within the Netball WA umpiring pathway. Feedback from coaches and teams regarding our umpires was positive and reflected the high standard of the umpiring group.

The Spring season delivered the Green Shirt Program with 36 participants. Umpires were paired two to one with mentors across eight weeks. Twelve umpires from the 2024 Green Shirt cohort were also included in the 2025 program to receive more intensive mentoring that had not been readily available during the Winter Season. As a result, eight of those umpires attained their National C Badge. All 2025 Green Shirt participants completed the program. The remaining umpires continue toward badging in 2026.

Testing panels operated throughout the year to assess emerging and Green Shirt umpires. Cadet C Badge Testers completed the MyLearning course and practical requirements, resulting in two new accredited testers in 2025. Nineteen umpires achieved C Badge accreditation during the year.

JNA umpires also supported the JETS program during the Metro League competition. Five senior umpires officiated across Perth venues during the six-week series, gaining exposure to higher level match environments.

Planning for 2026 will be focused on strengthening pathway clarity and performance standards. It is proposed that a senior squad will be introduced to prepare umpires for representative appointments, including the FTGAP Association Championships. It is hoped that a more structured, club based, mentoring framework will also be implemented to support consistent development and long-term sustainability of the umpiring group.

## JNA 2025 ASSOCIATION UMPIRE DEVELOPMENT OFFICER'S REPORT

### AUDO (GAME DAY)

In 2025, the JNA Board voted to split the JNA AUDO responsibilities into two distinct roles to better manage the growing demands of umpiring across competitions.

The JNA AUDO (Programs) role included the selection of umpires for Fuel to Go Championships, Metro League and Carnivals, inclusive of trials and development sessions where umpires were required. This role also continued to oversee the registration and coordination of the Spring Green Shirt Program.

A second role was introduced: JNA Game Day AUDO. This role was responsible for allocating umpires to all Winter Saturday and Monday matches, including Winter Finals. For the Spring season, this included allocation of umpires to Monday and Tuesday matches.

As this was a newly created role, new procedures were established to support its implementation. A dedicated communication chat was created to include the Umpire Coordinators from each club. A shared Game Day allocation sheet was distributed to club umpire coordinators, who were responsible for allocating their club umpires to their own scheduled games. The Game Day AUDO then reallocated umpires across clubs to maintain the integrity of unbiased umpiring for each match.

This system proved highly effective. It allowed flexibility when clubs were short of umpires, with the Game Day AUDO stepping in to allocate available officials where needed. Throughout the season, this collaborative approach fostered a friendly and accommodating working relationship between clubs, which was extremely positive to see develop.

45 Saturday games (8:00am – 2:30pm)

31 Monday games (5:00pm – 9:00pm)

##### Spring Season

30 Monday games (5:00pm – 8:30pm)

22 Tuesday games (4:5pm – 6:15pm)

With each game requiring two umpires, the demand for qualified officials throughout 2025 was significant.

The JNA Game Day AUDO and Badging Panel Approved Umpires also worked closely with the JNA Programs AUDO to identify Green Shirt umpires who were ready were assessed for C Badging, while continuing to mentor those requiring further development. A total of 19 Green Shirt and new umpires were successfully badged in 2025.

Looking ahead to 2026, game day umpiring will continue to strengthen, with an ongoing focus on umpire welfare, collaboration, development pathways and increased club participation to further enhance the quality and integrity of umpiring across the association.

## JNA 2025 NET SET GO CO-ORDINATORS' REPORT

This year has been a rewarding one for the JNA NET Program. Across the winter season, July holiday clinic and spring season, we had the privilege of working with a fantastic group of young athletes taking their first steps along their netball journey. The goal throughout was to keep sessions fun, inclusive and with athlete development focused on foundational netball skills, aided by plenty of encouragement from our team of coaches. Watching the athletes' confidence grow from week to week was a highlight for both of us.

The winter program ran across eight Saturday mornings and saw strong attendance, with 34 children registered. Sessions were planned consistent with the NSG resource framework and were designed to introduce the foundations of movement, passing, catching and teamwork in a way that kept everyone engaged, with a little bit of craziness sprinkled in. It was great to see so many families on the sidelines each week, supporting and encouraging the athletes and contributing to the positive atmosphere around the courts, even during one particularly torrential morning session!

During the July school holidays we hosted a one-day clinic with 19 participants across a wider age group including all NSG ages. This session gave the athletes a chance to try new activities, meet some different coaches and build new friendships within teams as well as across clubs. The clinic format also allowed us to spend more time on games-based learning, which the athletes responded to really well.

Our spring season rounded out the year and ran over eight Tuesday afternoons. This was our largest program of the year with 48 registrants. Energy levels were high (sometimes very, very high), and it was clear how much growth had taken place since winter. Spring often attracts both returning participants and first timers, and it was a pleasure welcoming new families into the association.

A significant portion of the success of our NET program this year belongs to the coaching group. All our coaches were young athletes from various clubs within the association who brought enthusiasm, patience and care to every session. They built great rapport with the athletes, created safe and supportive learning environments and showed tremendous potential as future coaches within JNA. We are grateful for the time they gave and the way they represented their clubs and the association throughout the year. Their contribution made a real difference.

Looking ahead, there will be some changes to the structure of the NET program in 2026 as clubs take on delivery of the winter program with support from the association. The aim is to keep growing participation and give clubs more opportunities to connect with young families. From our perspective as coordinators, we are focused on helping ensure that transition is smooth and that the program continues to give new players a positive start in netball. We look forward to building on the momentum of this year during our February clinic and supporting clubs and coaches as they prepare for the new model.

## JNA 2025 COMPETITION CO-ORDINATOR'S REPORT

This year I had the honour of taking on the full 2025 season as the competition coordinator for Joondalup Netball Association. This year has been one of strong participation, continued development, and excellent sportsmanship across all grades. My focus remained on delivering a well-organised, fair, and enjoyable competition for players, coaches, umpires, volunteers, and spectators.

### **Winter 2025**

- **Total teams registered:** 11U-Opens totalled 111 teams. NSG totalled 45 teams.
- **Total players:** 11U-Opens totalled 1242 players. NSG totalled 562 players.
- **Divisions/Grades run:** NSG, 11U, 12U, 13U, 15U, 18U, Opens

### **Spring 2025**

- **Total teams registered:** 11U-Opens totalled 97 teams. NSG totalled 56 teams.
- **Total players:** 11U-Opens totalled 1019 players. NSG totalled 592 players.
- **Divisions/Grades run:** NSG, 11U, 12U, 13U, 15U, 18U, Opens

This season saw steady growth in registrations making it harder to have well balanced competitions.

While the seasons were highly successful, a few challenges were encountered such as fixturing teams in a short manner of time, inconsistencies on grading forms from clubs, not being able to have a straight season with a full played ladder meaning there were quite a few age groups and divisions with non-scoring rounds and sudden court changes.

Despite these challenges, the association was able to adapt and cooperate with all involved and tried to ensure minimal disruption to the quality of competition.

Regarding finals for Winter and Spring, a brief summary follows:

Moving into the 2026 season I would push the following plans and goals:

- Improvements to scheduling, communication, or systems
- Grading forms are to be configured to ensure that as much information as possible can be entered. Winter season alone, majority of the forms stated "as previous season" or had no comments at all. There should be the decision noted on forms of "no comments noted will be at discretion of the coordinator" to ensure clubs are held accountable.
- Because the association is small, I feel removing the "grading committee" and repurposing the club grading meeting where each club volunteers a representative to go through an age group with another club representative and determine the divisions. This would then come to the coordinator who would process the results with the board and then have these published in a timely manner.
- For Winter, grading would be recommended to have the first 5 weeks posted on site but have a "mini" regrade after week 3. After these rounds are completed, there are not to be any further changes so that each age group are able to have a full 10-week graded season.
- For Spring, clubs are to confirm all grading forms are correctly entered and once these have been posted the divisions are set for the full 8 weeks.
- Updating competition rules or policies and emailing out these changes
- Growing team numbers and improving pathway opportunities

I look forward to building on this season’s achievements and continuing to strengthen our competition.

## JNA 2025 ACSRA REPRESENTATIVE'S REPORT

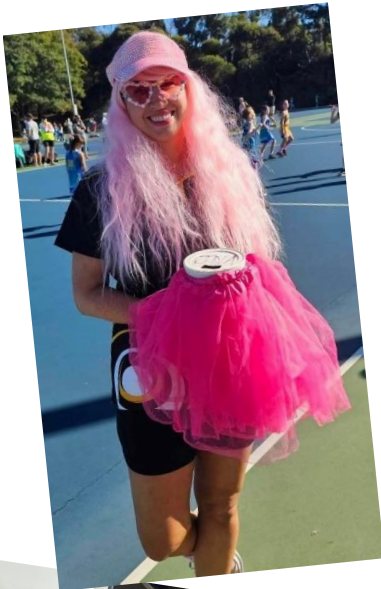

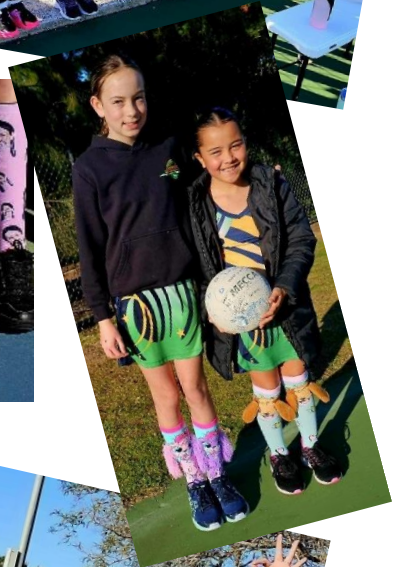
